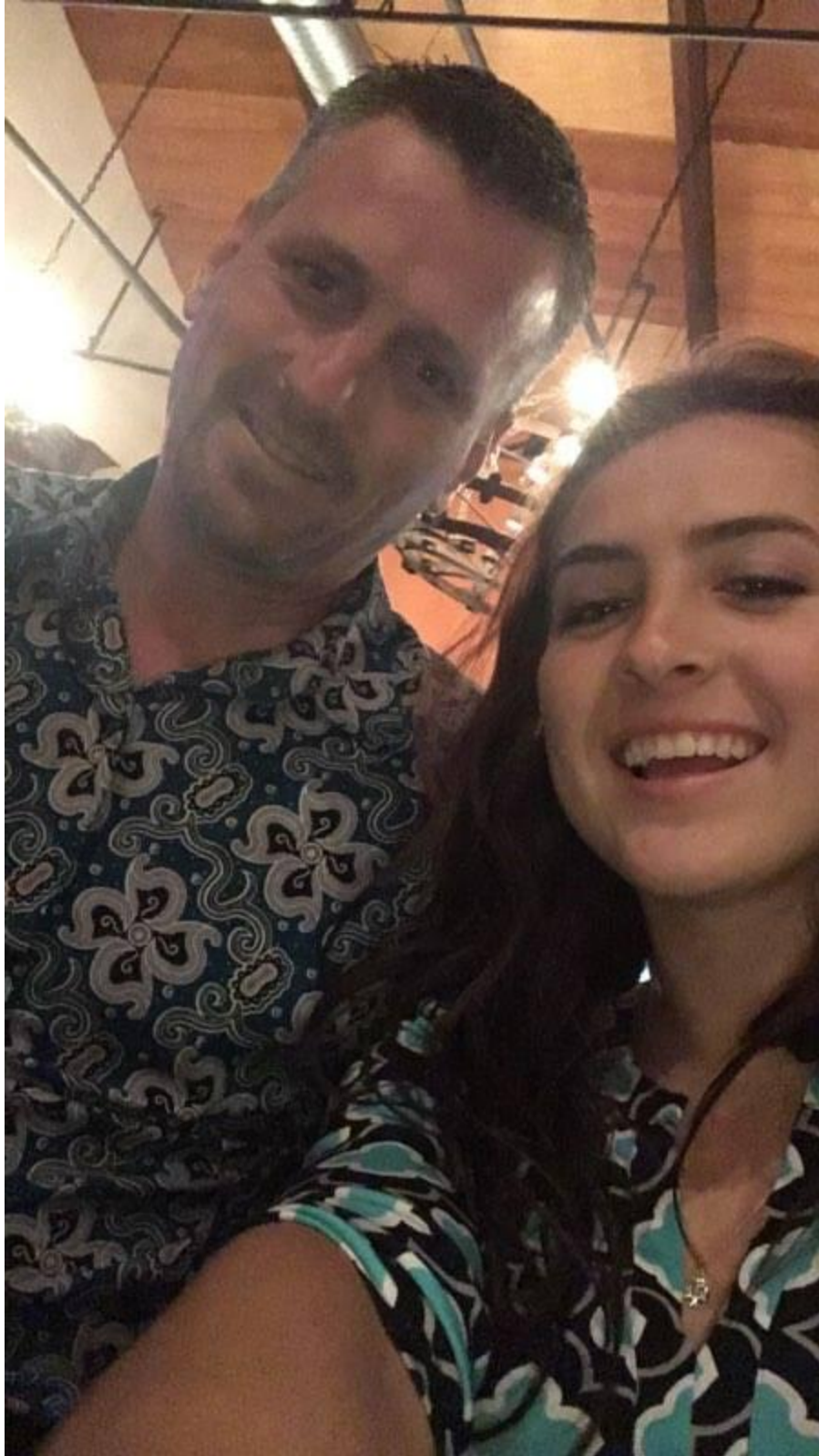






This little one just turned 14 this week!!! Time has flown so fast and Mia brings much joy into our home!
